

Unley Primary School Sports Day: Wednesday 10 November 2021

Dear families,

Excitement for Sports Day is building, and we're looking forward to being all together once again at Unley Oval next Wednesday 10 November at 9.15am. Family and friends are invited to come along and be part of the wonderful community spirit that defines the day. Please find overleaf a brief program of events.

Upon advice from the education department, we are asking that all adults who plan to come to Sports Day register their attendance ahead of time using our school's SkoolBag App. We also need parents to provide permission for their child to take the short walk to Unley Oval with their class. You will see both of these electronic forms on the SkoolBag App under the EFORMS tab. Please complete a different short walk permission for each child you have at school. Please complete these forms by next Monday 8 November.

In addition to this register, all adults who attend Unley Oval on the day will be required to check in using the COVID Safe QR code available at various locations. Adults will need to maintain the physical distancing principle of at least 1.5 metres separation. This does not apply to members of the same household.

All children Reception to Year 7 are organised into house teams for Sports Day. Class teachers will let you know your child's house colour. Congratulations to the following Year 6 and 7 house captains.

At the start of the day, students must meet their teacher in the classroom by 9.00am as per normal so teachers can take the roll and mark any absences. Please ensure your child is at school on time as shortly after 9.00am classes will walk together to Unley Oval, ready to begin the program of events at 9.15am. Students are expected to remain with their class for all events. Your help with this is appreciated.

To help with the smooth-running of the day, please take note of the following points:

- Students need to wear suitable, sun-safe clothes, including a t-shirt with covered shoulders in their house team colour (no singlets), sports shoes and a sun-safe hat.
- Students should come to school with sunscreen already applied.
- Students may colour their hair in their house colour at home if they wish, but there are to be no aerosol cans brought to school.

Students will need to bring:

- A named drink bottle of water.
- A packed recess and lunch, including plenty of high-energy snacks.
- A named, sun-safe hat (bucket hat or legionnaire hat – no caps).

Teachers will provide students with sunscreen to apply regularly. We will also ensure we have ready access to any medication that students require, according to their health plans.

Fresh fruit will be provided to all students on the day with thanks to the generous support of a local family business, Tony and Mark's. Please note that lunch orders will not be available on Sports Day.

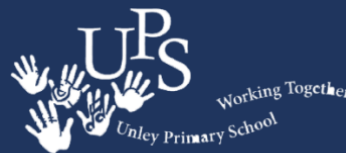
A coffee van will be available at Unley Oval for adults to purchase a variety of drinks. We ask that parents do not purchase hot drinks for their child.
